- Lab testing, medications, case management, screenings. Hepatitis C, diabetes, dental clinics
- Must have household income below 150% of the federal poverty line, be uninsured, and have a documented source of income

- Community clinic providing care to all adult patients regardless of insurance status, min. \$5 copay, must bring ID, proof of income, tax return
